
Rocky Mountain Power would be interested in a future 138 kilovolt transmission line on the proposed Utah Lake Causeway based on the following:

- The causeway will cross approximately from Pelican Point on the west side of the lake to Vineyard on the east side of the lake.
- The causeway itself will be approximately 20 to 30 feet above the lake surface.
- The causeway will consist of four lanes, two in each direction.

Rocky Mountain Power would prefer that the future transmission line be in the median. Sufficient room should exist to do construction, maintenance and restoration work without blocking more than one lane in each direction.

Rocky Mountain Power cannot state exactly when the transmission line will be required. It is believed that the right-of-way can be utilized within the next 15 years. Rocky Mountain Power would pursue acquiring easement when the transmission line is required.
